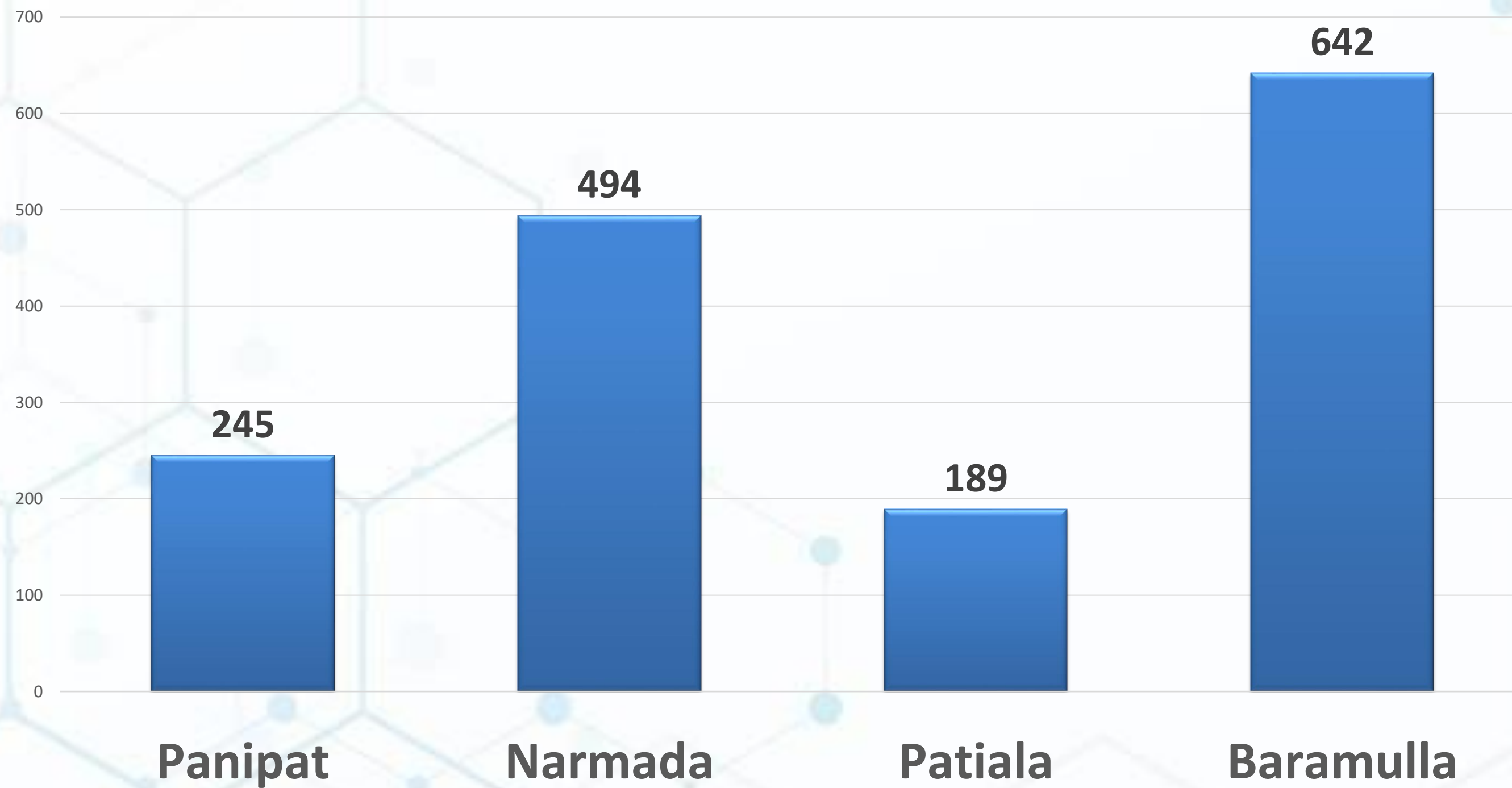

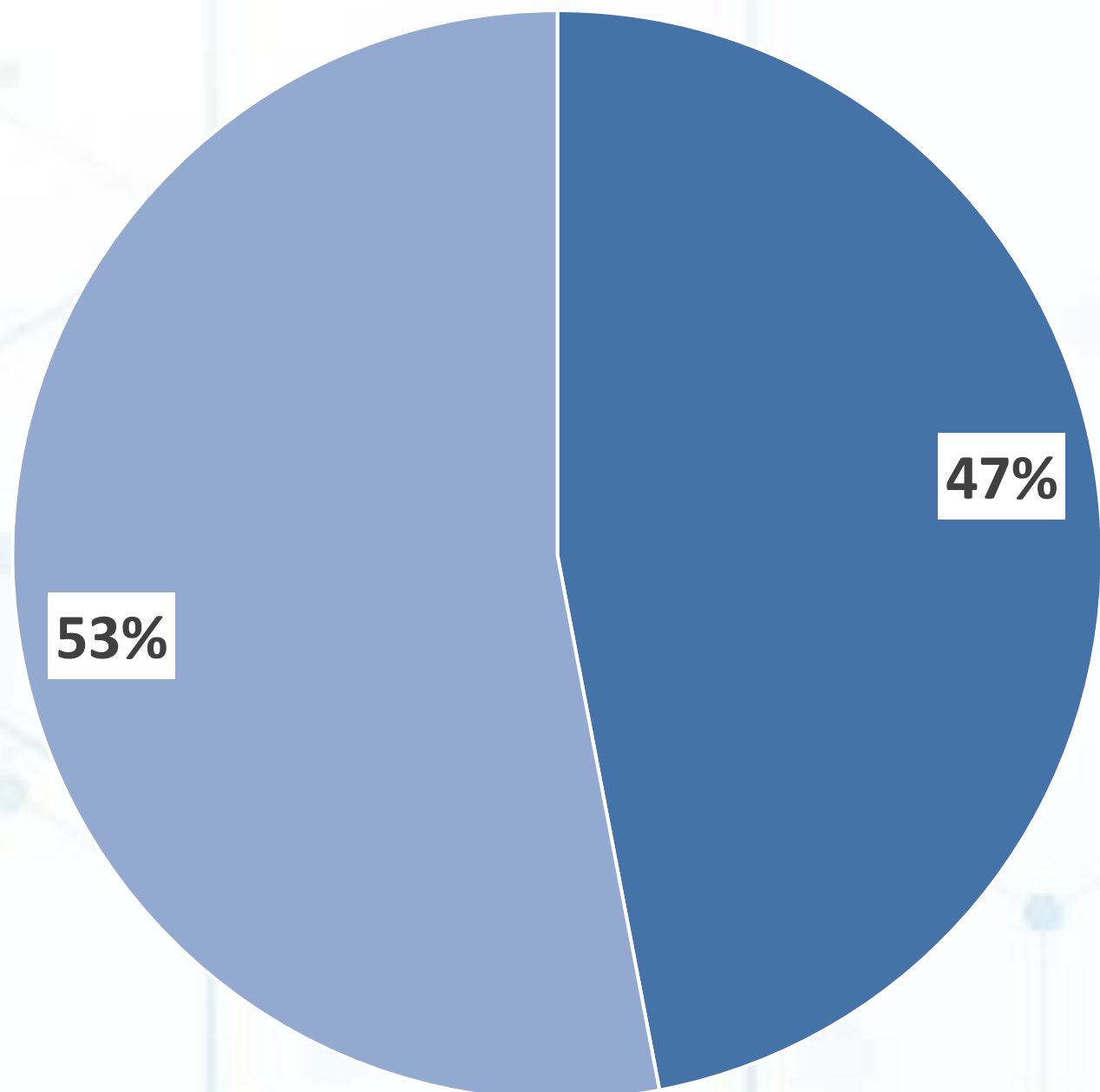


Geographic Impact :

Beneficiaries



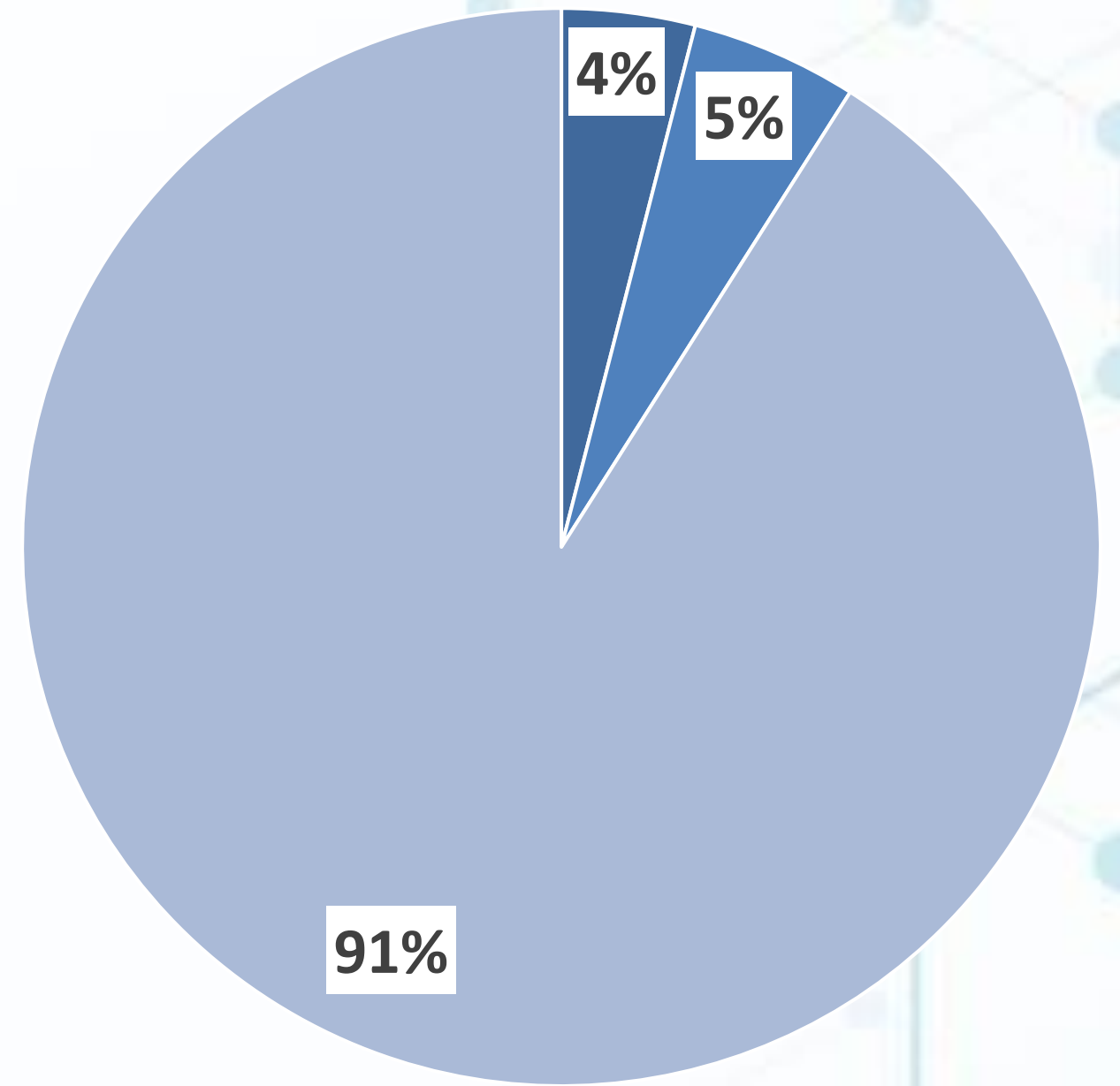
Gender wise analysis of Beneficiaries

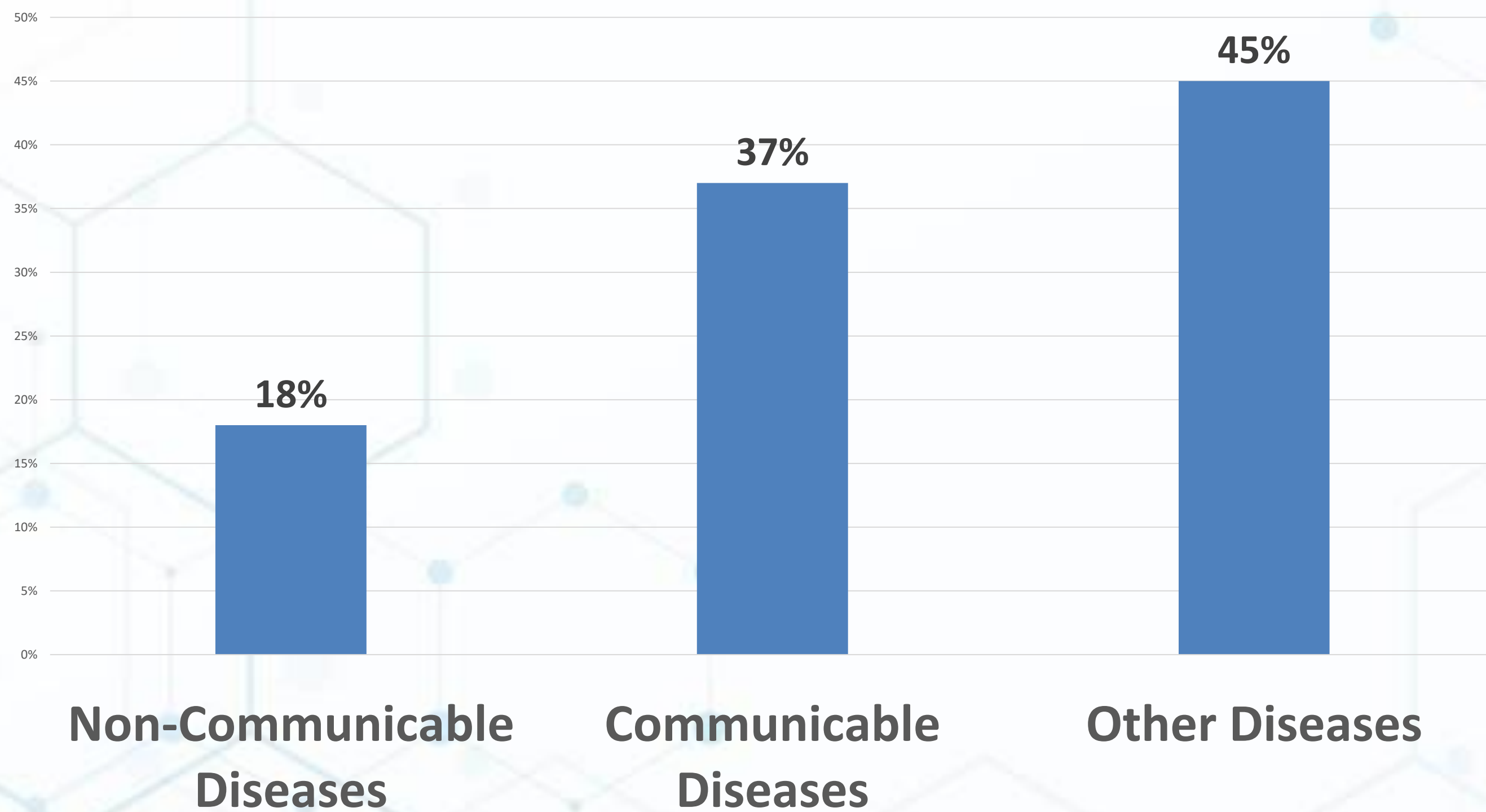
