16 cloudbursts, 3 flash
floods

July 28–29, 2025:
Second wave of
intense rain (198 mm)

Aftermath of The Flood:

Casualties & Displacement

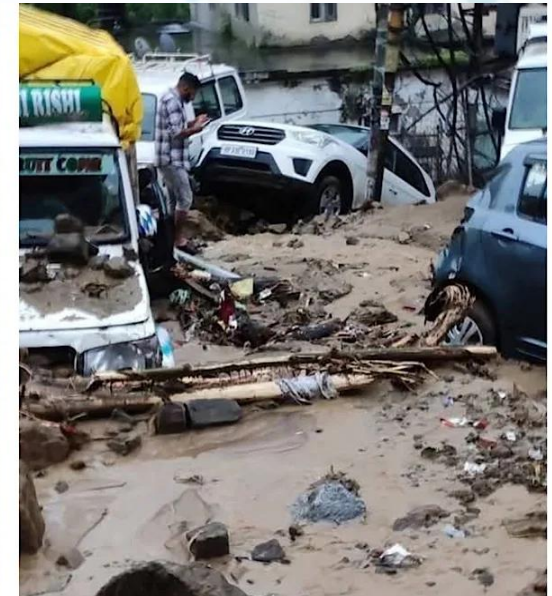
- Multiple fatalities
- Hundreds displaced, homes destroyed

Infrastructure Damage

- Roads, bridges, communication, water, and power lines affected

Livelihood & Health Impact

- Shops, crops, cattle lost
- Rise in waterborne diseases (diarrhea, dengue)
- Mental health stress in families



Cloudbursts and Flashfloods in Mandi

Gohar was among the worst-hit areas during the **July 2025 cloudbursts and flash floods**.

- Multiple villages were affected, resulting in **loss of life**, damaged homes, and washed-away infrastructure.

About the Camp

Location: Gohar, Mandi – one of the worst affected regions

Duration: 5 Days

Team: Sparsh Sanjeevani Mobile Medical Team with District Health Officials

Activities:

- Primary healthcare camps
- Door-to-door medical outreach
- Essential medicine distribution
- Health education and hygiene awareness

Day-wise Summary of Consultations

Date	Village	Consultations	Common Diagnoses
25 July	Chachiot	23	Gastroenteritis, fever, cold and cough
26 July	Dari	30	Flu, skin allergy, stomach pain
27 July	Bassa	29	Fever, cold, cough, vomiting
28 July	Nougraun	31	Diarrhea, respiratory infections
29 July	Narhali	42	Skin allergies, stomach pain, fever, cold & cough



Health Interventions & Education

Medical Focus:

First aid, wound care, infection control
Prevention of waterborne diseases

Community Education:

Hygiene practices
Safe drinking water use
Identifying early signs of infection



Outcomes & Impact

- 155 individuals treated
- Early intervention prevented further infections.
- Community awareness on hygiene and sanitation improved
- Strengthened trust between the medical team and local population
